At a first workshop on 20th of February in Magdeburg, the European Chemical Regions together with the German Chemical Industry Association and Chemical Companies in Central Germany took the opportunity to bring together representatives from chemical companies, logistic service providers as well as representatives from the regional, national and European level to discuss about further co-operation in the field of chemical logistics.
