On December 1st 2008 the phase for pre-registration of chemical substances under the new European Regulation REACH ended. Now new activities follow: the exchange of data between manufacturers of the same substance if they intend to organise a common registration. Moreover, REACH forces registrants into exchange of data concerning animal testing.

For most of the enterprises these sharing activities are new in view of competition and concerning data for regulatory demands.

In the framework of Enterprise Europe Network (EEN) the ZENIT institution in North Rhine –Westphalia, Germany, would like to support enterprises and continue the series for webinars that started successfully with information on pre-registration.
