Enforcement of data bank on substance-related EU regulations

Proposal:

ECRN asks ECHA:

- To play a positive role for developing common enforcement strategies for substance-related EU legislation at the EU level
- To start – at an early stage – to set up a data bank for all substances that are regulated under the enforcement activities in EU legislation.
